Aikin Elementary will provide each parent with an individual student report about their child's performance on the State assessment in at least math, language arts, and reading. This will include:

• STAAR test results and a letter of explanation for clarity.

7. Assisting Parents in Understanding Key Educational Topics

Aikin Elementary will assist parents in understanding important academic topics through the following actions:

- The state's academic content standards
- Student academic achievement standards
- Academic assessments (including alternate assessments)
- Requirements of Title I, Part A
- How to monitor their child's progress
- Strategies for working with educators

This will be achieved through:

• Online Learning, PTA Meetings, Meet the Teacher Night, Paper and Electronic Handouts, Newsletters, Automated Phone Calls, Personal Phone Calls, Parent/Teacher Conferences, Access to the internet via district-provided technology devices, Teacher and Staff Attendance at Parent Engagement Conferences
