Parent and Family Engagement Policy

1. Liberty JH will take the following actions to involve parents in the joint development of its school parent and family engagement plan under section 1118 of the ESEA:

Liberty JH will hold an annual meeting to inform parents of the school's participation in Title I, Part A programs, and to explain the Title I, Part A requirements and the right of parents to be involved in Title I, Part A programs. The school will convene the meeting at a time convenient for parents and will offer a flexible number of additional parent and family engagement meetings, such as in the morning or evening, so that as many parents as possible are able to attend. The school will invite all parents of children participating in Title I, Part A programs to this meeting, and will encourage them to attend by:

 - Radio Station within 2 mile radius of school
 - Social Media

 - Text Messages
 - Electronic reminders
4. Liberty JH will provide parents of participating children information in a timely manner about Title I, Part A programs that includes a description and explanation of the school's curriculum, the forms of academic assessment used to measure children's progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet by:
 - Individual Teacher Syllabus
 - Parent Letter English/Spanish
 - FOCUS - internet access to student grades
5. Liberty JH will at the request of parents, provide opportunities for regular meetings for parents to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions about the education of their children. The school will respond to any such suggestions as soon as practicably possible by:
 - Follow up in next meeting
 - Letter, phone call or email
6. Liberty JH will provide each parent an individual student report about the performance of their child on the State assessment in at least math, language arts and reading by:
 - Parents will receive their student's STAAR test results, and a letter of explanation.
