What is Title One?

Originally Title One was part of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965.

Title One was intended to provide financial assistance to schools to meet the special needs of educationally deprived children. Currently, Title One is designed to help schools provide a higher quality education to ensure that Every Student Succeeds.

How Does a School Receive Title One Funds?

The federal government provides funding to each state each year for Title One programs. The Department of Education determines the amount of Title One funding that our School District will receive each year based on a formula that includes the number of children from low-income families who reside in our district. When the school district receives this funding, we are then responsible for providing services to students on the basis of educational need rather than family income.

What Does Title One Really Do at Terrace Elementary?

- Provides funds for activities that involve families.
- Provides funds to purchase instructional materials and resources for teachers to use in their classrooms.
- Provides salaries and materials for a Campus Math Specialist and Campus Reading Specialists.
- Provides funds to purchase equipment for use in the school's instructional programs.
- Provides funds for additional training for teachers and staff.
- Terrace Elementary places great importance on building and developing a partnership with families to help children achieve high academic standards.
