## **Parent & Family Engagement (PFE) Program**

### **What Is the PFE Program?**

Little Rams Little Wildcats (LRLW) is committed to providing a high-quality, individualized education for each student. We build strong partnerships with families and the community.

LRLW will:

- Establish a Site-Based Decision-Making Committee (SBDMC) including staff, parents, and community members.
- Hold regular meetings to gather input from families and the community.
- Distribute this policy by:
  - Posting it on the district website.
  - Sending a printed copy home with each student.
  - Sharing printed copies or QR codes at annual meetings.
- Provide a representative at each Annual Title I Meeting and PFE event.
- Provide teacher qualifications upon request.
- Conduct evaluations of all PFE events and share results.
- Review and revise the Parent & Family Engagement Policy and School-Parent Compact annually.
- Train district employees on effective family engagement strategies.
