- Use appropriate problem-solving strategies when facing challenges or conflicts
- Communicate openly with staff about my progress, struggles, and concerns
- Work toward my behavioral and academic goals as outlined in my placement plan
- Demonstrate readiness skills for successful reintegration to my home school
- Engage in community service or restorative activities as assigned
- Maintain appropriate behavior during transportation to and from school

#### As a Parent/Guardian, I agree to:

- Communicate daily with my child about their school experience and progress
- Attend all required conferences, meetings, and check-ins with school staff
- Support and reinforce the behavioral expectations and consequences at home
- Collaborate with school staff on intervention strategies
- Monitor my child's completion of classwork and/or homework
- Ensure my child attends school regularly and notify the school of any absences
- Participate in parent education programs as recommended
- Communicate immediately with school staff about any concerns or changes at home
- Support the discipline policies and consequences of the alternative school program
- Work with the school team to prepare for my child's successful reintegration Attend transition meetings and planning sessions for return to home school

# As a Teacher, I agree to:

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- Provide instruction that meets each student's academic and behavioral needs
- Implement evidence-based behavioral interventions and positive reinforcement strategies
- Maintain clear, consistent expectations and consequences for all students
- Communicate regularly and effectively with parents about academic progress and behavioral concerns
- Document student progress toward behavioral and academic goals as required by the District and law
- Provide a structured, safe learning environment that promotes positive choices
- Model conflict resolution, anger management, and social skills as part of daily instruction
- Collaborate with counselors, administrators, and support staff on student intervention plans
- Prepare students academically for successful reintegration to their home schools
- Model appropriate behavior and maintain professional boundaries at all times
- Provide meaningful learning experiences that engage students and build confidence
- Support each student's individual pathway toward behavioral improvement

# As an Administrator, I agree to:

- Ensure high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables children served under Title I, Part A to meet the challenging State academic standards
- Provide clear program expectations, policies, and procedures to students and families
- Ensure that two (2) parent-teacher conferences are offered annually during which the compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement
- Ensure reasonable access to staff, opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to the extent legally and practically possible, observation of classroom activities
- Ensure a safe, structured environment conducive to behavioral change and learning
- Coordinate comprehensive support services including counseling and intervention programs
- Monitor student progress and adjust placement plans as needed
